We must make a prompt start leaving York as it is a fairly long journey to Derbyshire, through some beautiful scenery. We will have a brief comfort/coffee stop en route to Tissington where we will have a conducted tour of the house. Tissington Hall, which is owned by the FitzHerberts, has been in the family for the best part of 500 years. It has wonderful panelling and some fine Old Masters.

From Tissington, it is a short journey to Sudbury Hall (NT) which has some very richly decorated interiors including carvings by Grinling Gibbons. The main house is a 17thC family home; the nineteenth century wing now houses the National Museum of Childhood.

There is a good café at Sudbury but it is suggested you might bring a sandwich lunch as we won't arrive until after one o'clock and the grounds and gardens here are lovely, with places to picnic. Let's hope the weather is kind.

*The cost for Friends of York Art Gallery who are also members of the National Trust is £27.00. This includes travel, entry and tour of Tissington Hall, entry to Sudbury Hall and driver's gratuity. For guests who are NT members, the cost is £30. Non-NT members will need to purchase a ticket at Sudbury - £6.80 (house and gardens only) or £12.50 (includes National Museum of Childhood).
