**The Churches of St Denys and St Martin-le-Grand**

As a direct consequence of the very successful evening at the Stained Glass Centre in St Martin-cum-Gregory in August last year, we are delighted to announce that the Stained Glass Trust and the Friends of York Art Gallery are joining forces to offer two guided walks to look in some detail at the stained glass of four York churches. This first walk will be guided by Phil Thomas and Keith Barley, both leading members of the Trust, who between them are expert in both the art and conservation of stained glass. A second walk will cover the glass in All Saints', Pavement, and All Saints, North Street (*see separate flier*).

The walk on **Thursday 2 July** is scheduled to last approximately one-and-a-half hours, starting at 5.30 p.m. at the entrance to St Denys. The cost of the walk will be £14 and entry will be by ticket only, purchased in advance. Numbers will be strictly limited to 20.
